6/7 Camp

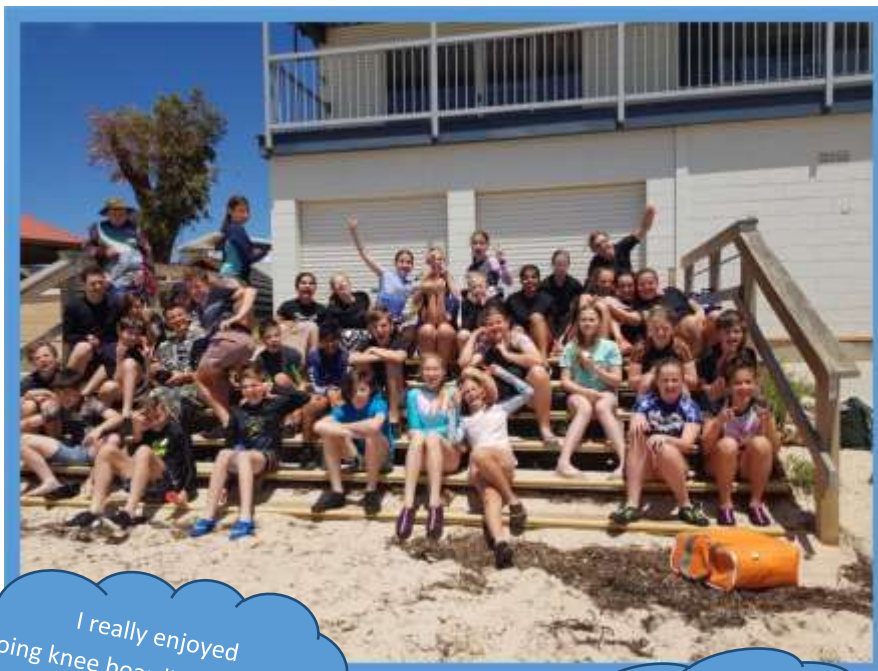

Remembrance Day

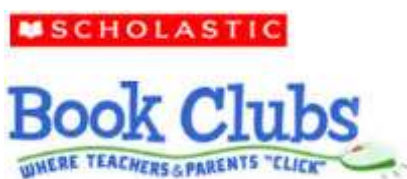
Sophie and Tayte represented our school on Monday at the Remembrance Day Ceremony in Renmark and placed a wreath on behalf of Renmark West Primary.
