Mary Mattner and Bev Crowhurst are leaving us at the end of 2019.

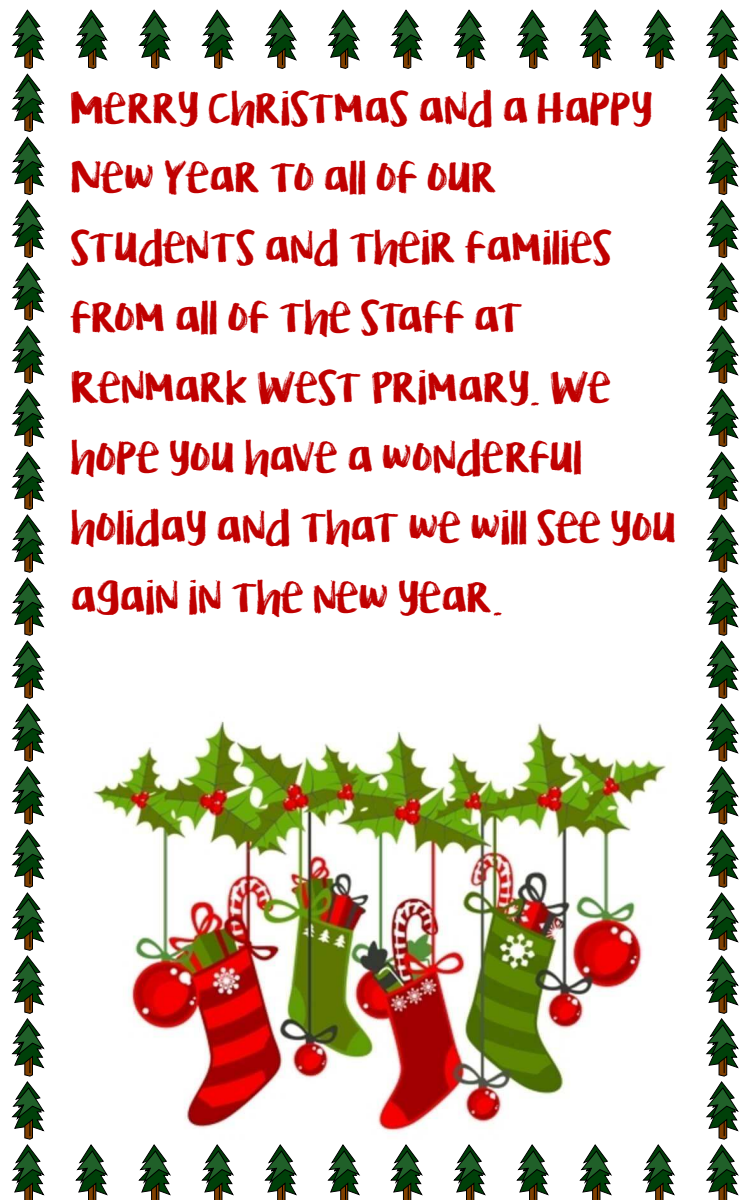
