# From the Principal

Dear Parents and Friends of Renmark West,

## The New Fence

By now you have probably seen the new fence and it looks great. The gates can be opened by adults and older students and are not locked during the day so you are still able to come in when you need to. Junior Primary students will need to have an adult or older student with them to access the gate 's opening mechanism.

Over the weekends there will still be access to the school through the gates at any of the entrances. Families who enjoy using the facility over the weekends or after school will still be able to do so.

## Back Playground

Over the holidays the back playground was removed as it no longer met the standards of safety for a playground.

Governing Council considered repairs to the equipment but this would have been costly and probably not an efficient use of funds.

Now we have a large sand area for students to use at recess and lunchtime. We have purchased a whole range of sand and water play toys that will arrive soon to make this area a good place for junior primary students to play.

In the long term the Governing Council would like to develop this area as a nature play zone for our students.

## Writing Club

This term we will be having writing club on a Monday and Wednesday morning at 10.10 am. The whole school is involved in this

writing initiative with students allocated to different cross year level groups.

Our students have been grouped according to their needs in writing and will have small group support to improve their writing and move to the next score band.

Students have been grouped based on a narrative assessment that we administered in Term 1.

Writing Club will last for 5 weeks and in week 6 students will have another assessment on narrative writing to determine if there has been improvement.
